Notice of Public Meeting Called By Llangarron Parish Council

Thursday 14th July 7 p.m.

Llangrove Village Hall

Councillors wish to make residents fully aware of Herefordshire Council's Local Plan for 2021 – 2041 and particularly on how those plans could impact on Llangrove.

Councillors were first made aware of the proposals at a briefing for Parish Councils on 20th June and Councillors unanimously voted to hold a public meeting at the PC meeting held on 28th June.

On the Parish Council's website we have placed a link to the proposals for Rural Areas so that residents can comment directly now if they so wish. The deadline for online comments is the 29th July 2022.

The reason that the Parish Council considers it important to brief residents is that currently Llangrove has been designated by Herefordshire Council as a sustainable settlement capable of further growth.

Their proposal affects 39 villages in Herefordshire.

We have questioned Herefordshire Council's foundation and strategy and will be commenting further on their definition of sustainability.

At the meeting it is our intention to run through the Herefordshire Council presentation and enable residents to have their say before the deadline with some suggested lines of approach.

Finally, it is important to recognise that these proposals only affect Llangrove and no other settlement within the parish which have been deemed by Herefordshire as open countryside.

Please therefore come to the meeting so that you can have an informed opinion on the Herefordshire Local Plan.
